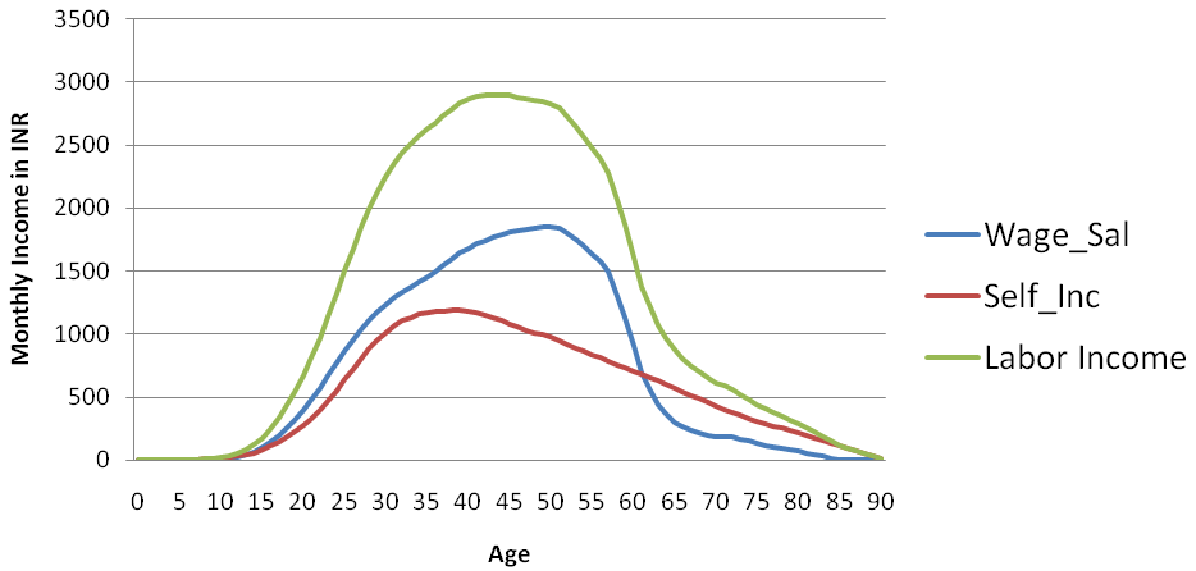
## **ISSUES**

- 3. Where to account household current debt and credit with grocery shop?**

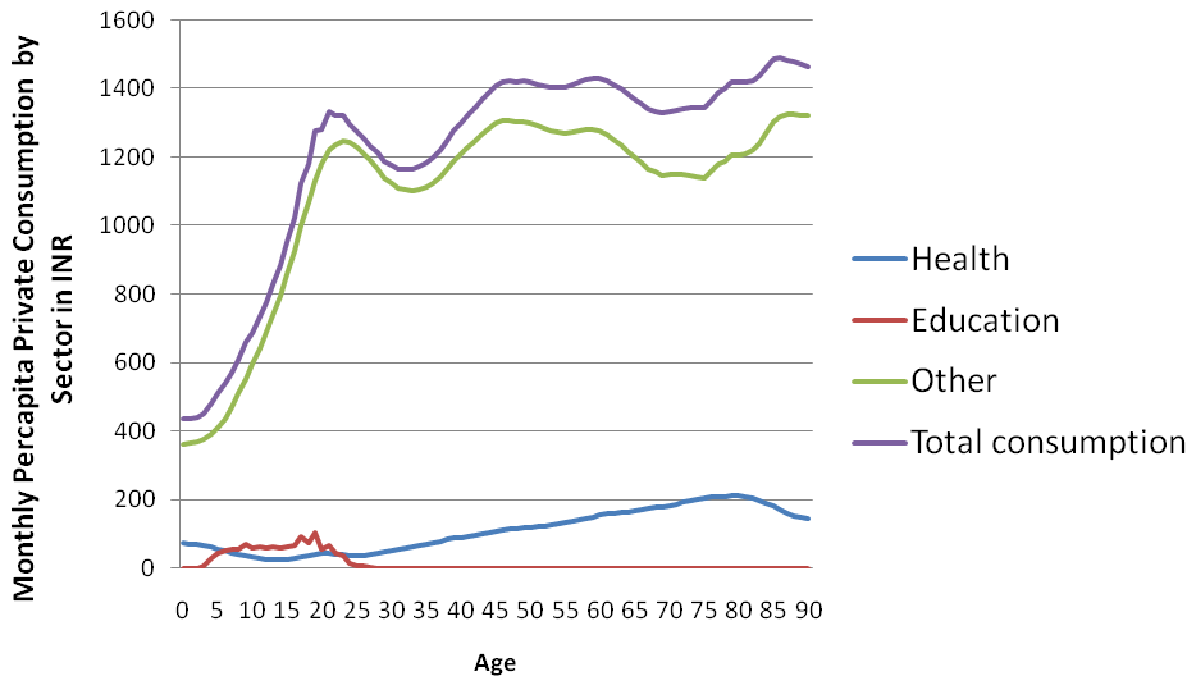
## **MICRO DATA**

- 2. There are id of individuals in household business and farm, mixed income assigned to such individuals.**

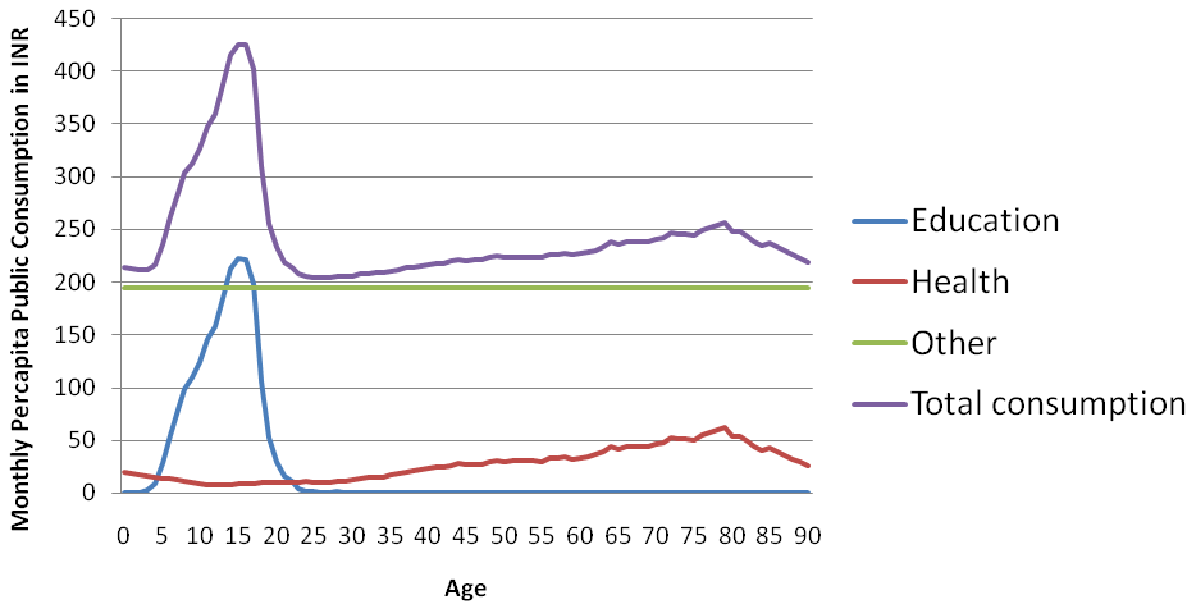
### Labor Income by Components, India 2004



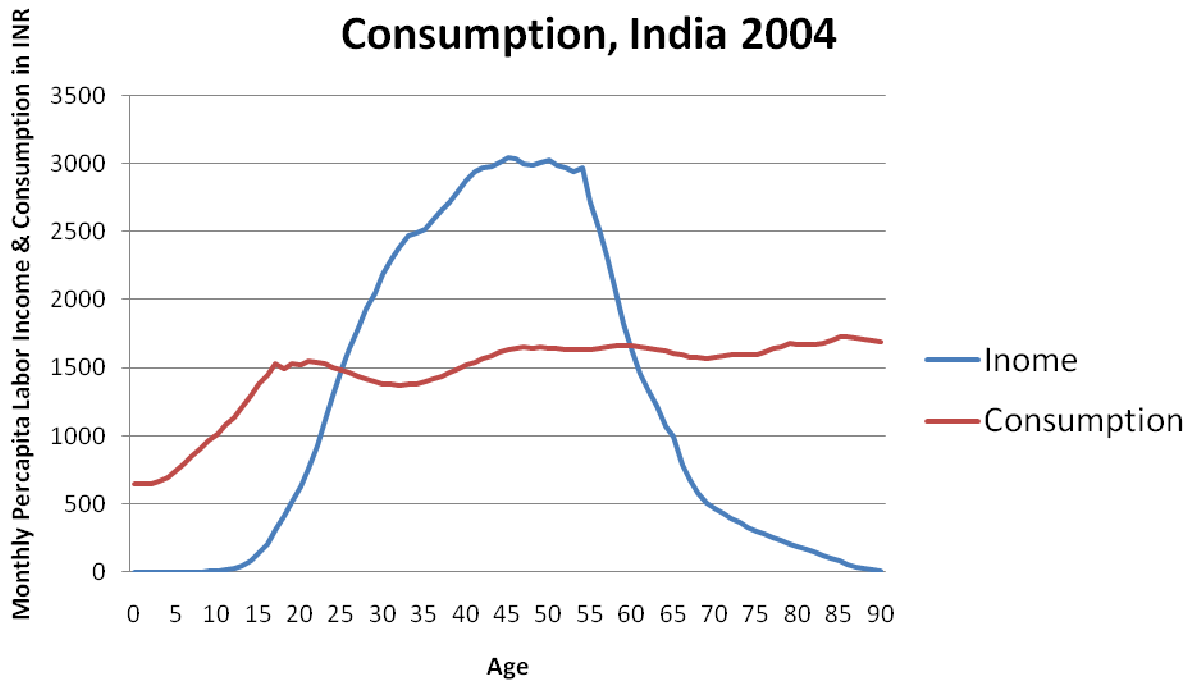
### Percapita Private Consumption by Sector, India 2004



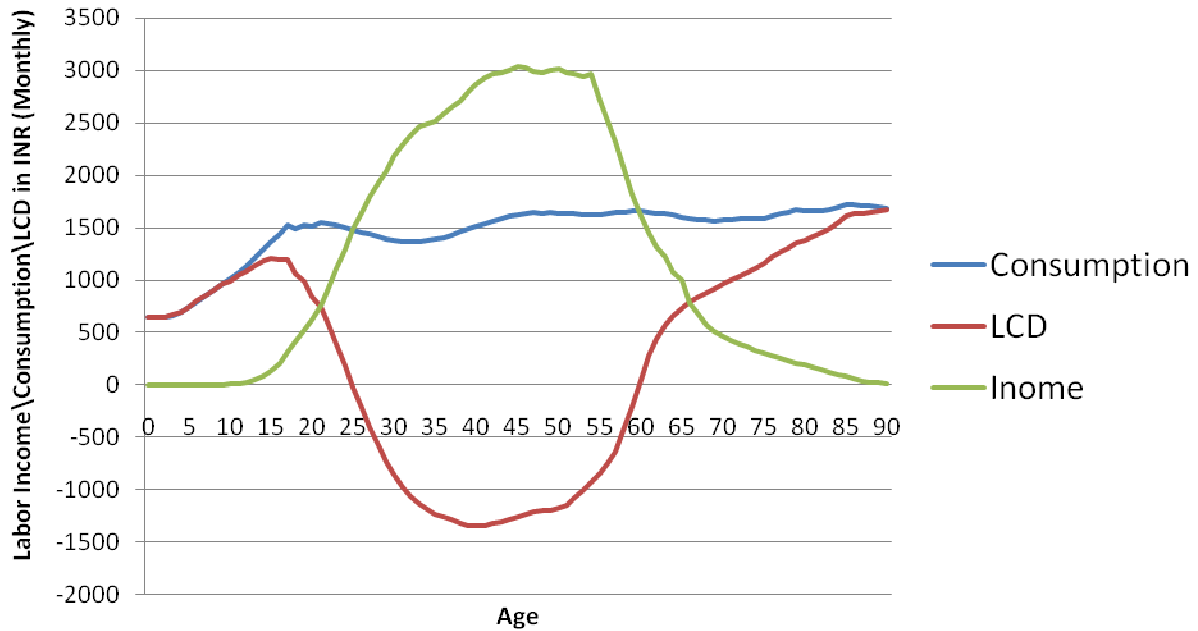
### Percapita Public Consumption by Sector, India 2004



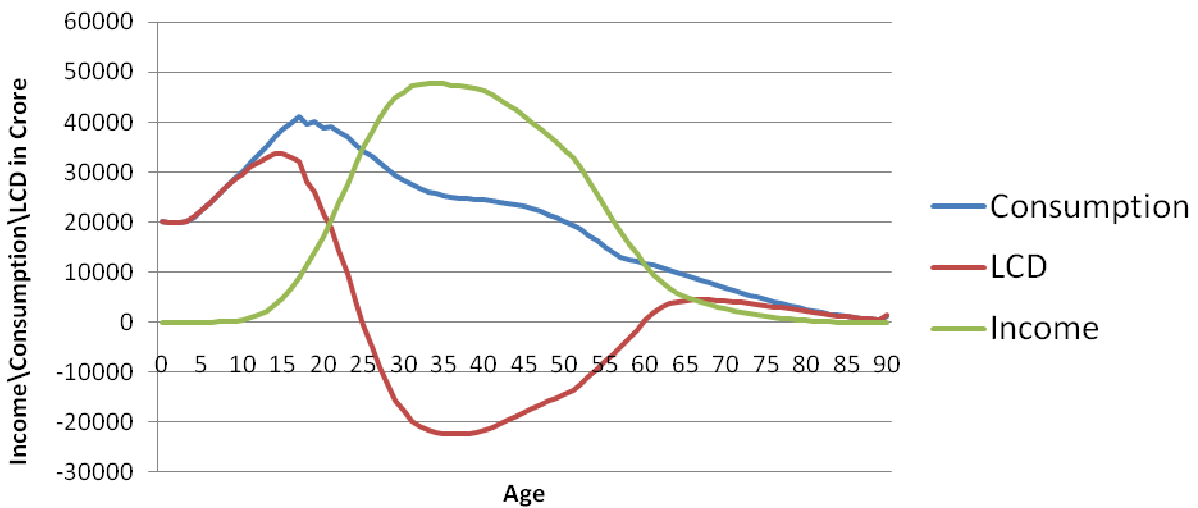
### Percapita Labor Income & Total Consumption, India 2004



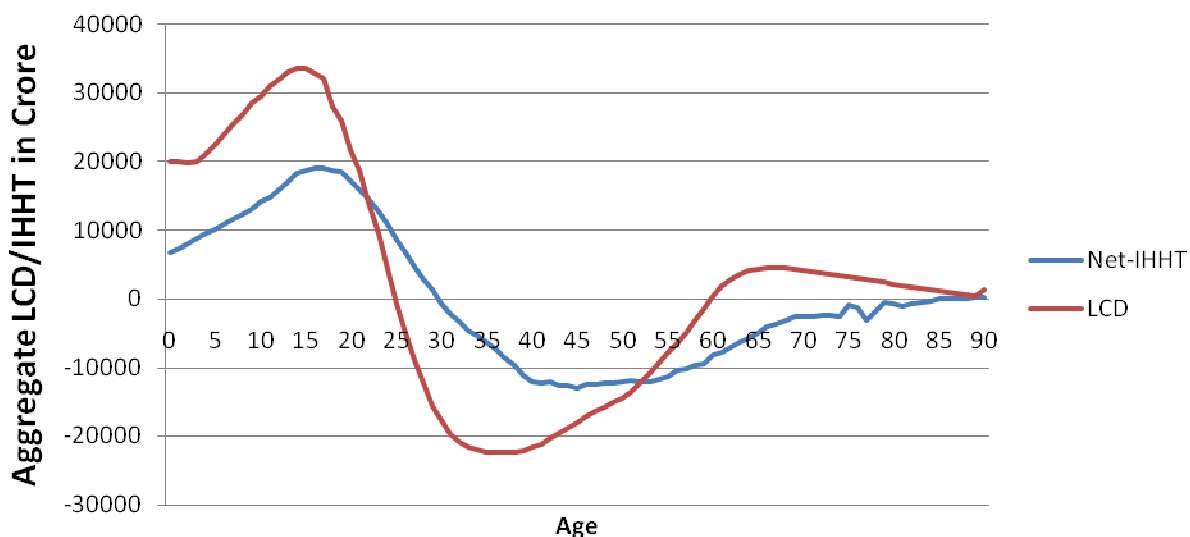

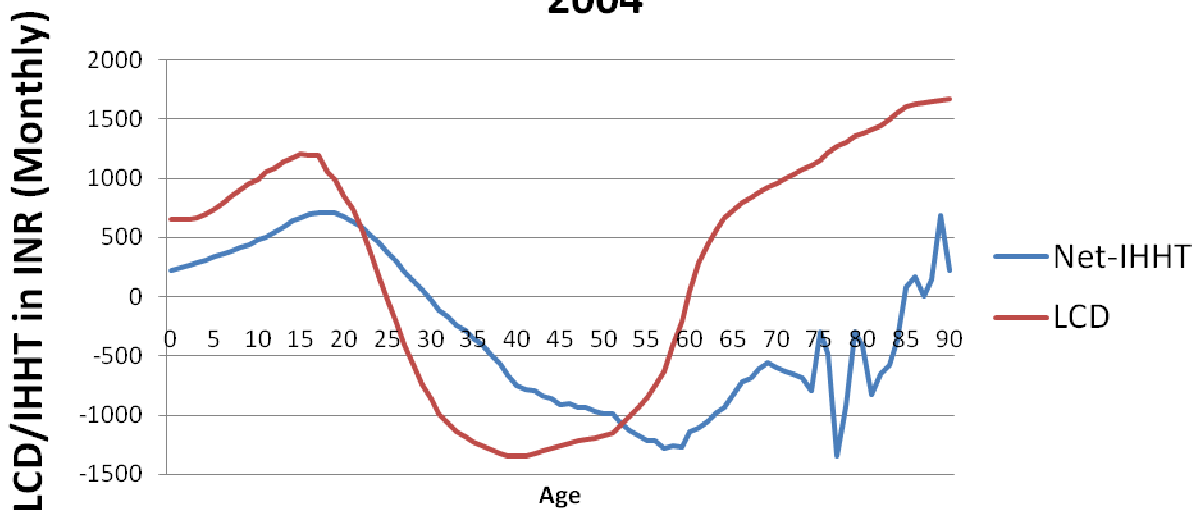
**Aggregate Labor Income Consumption & LCD, India
