

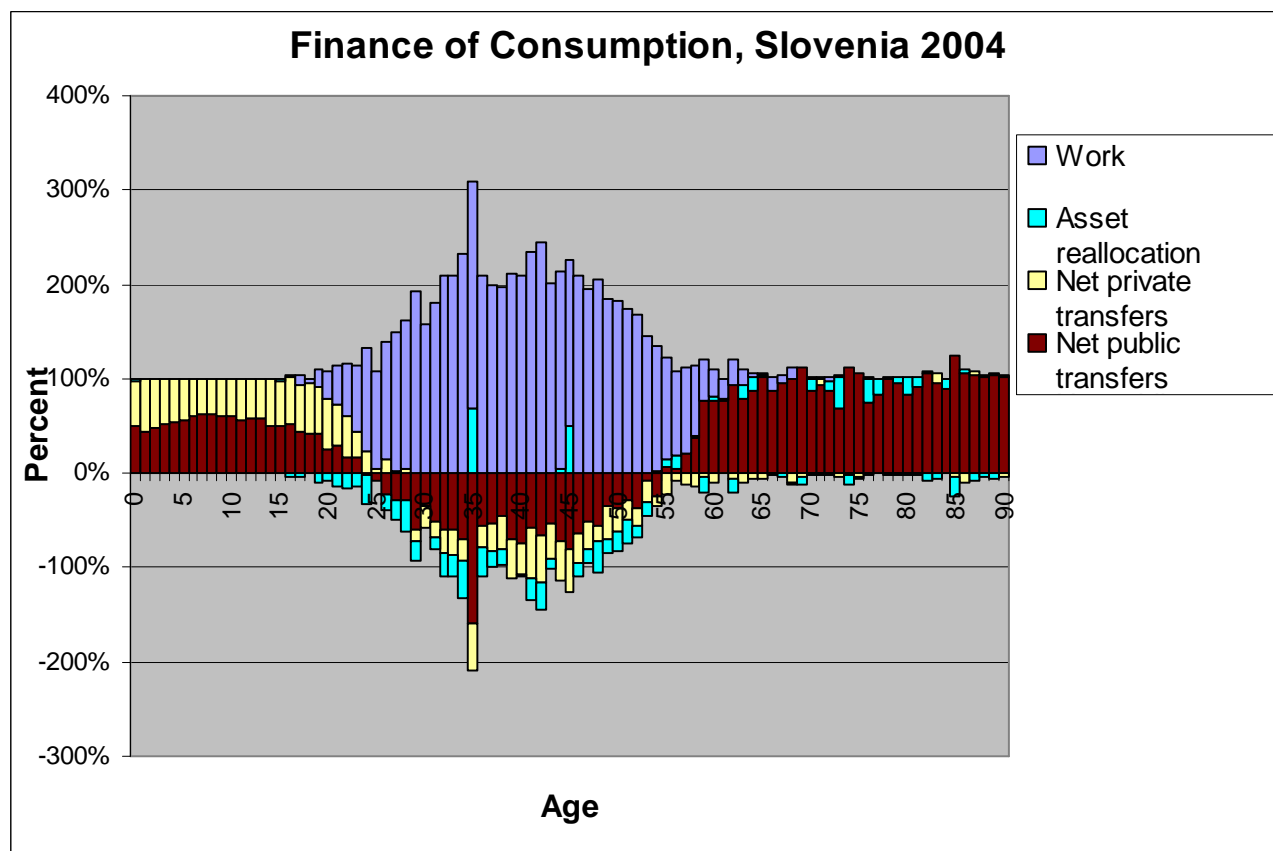

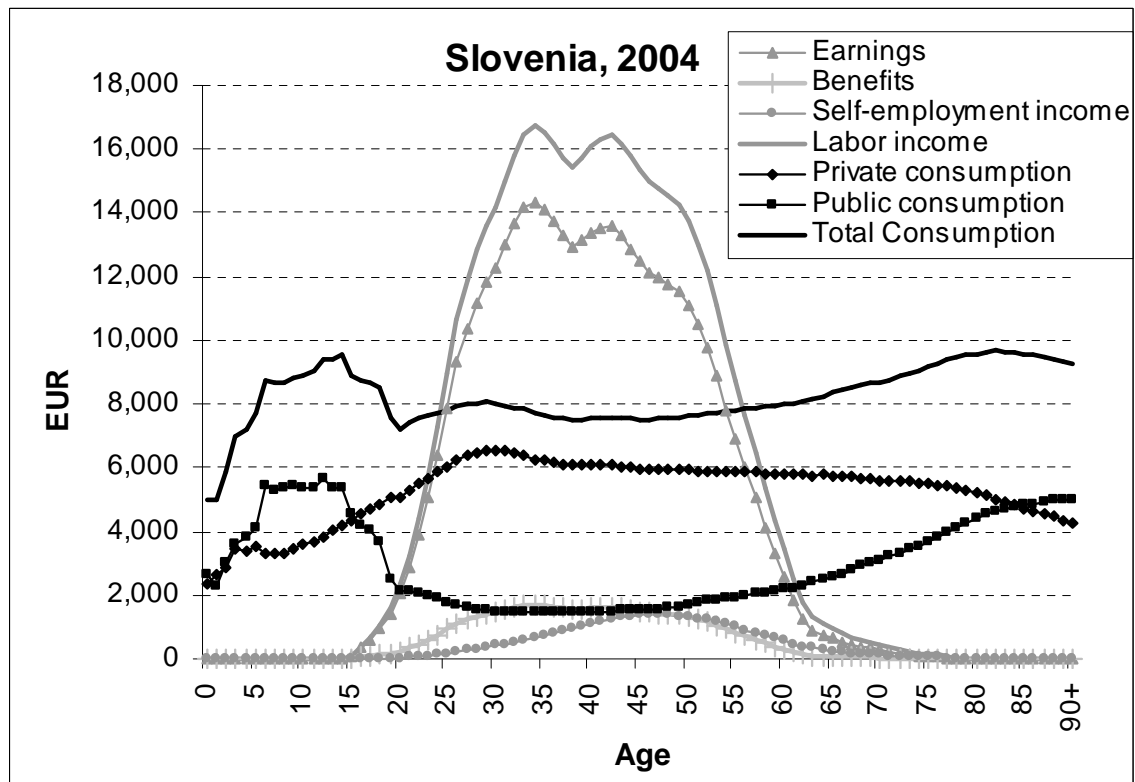
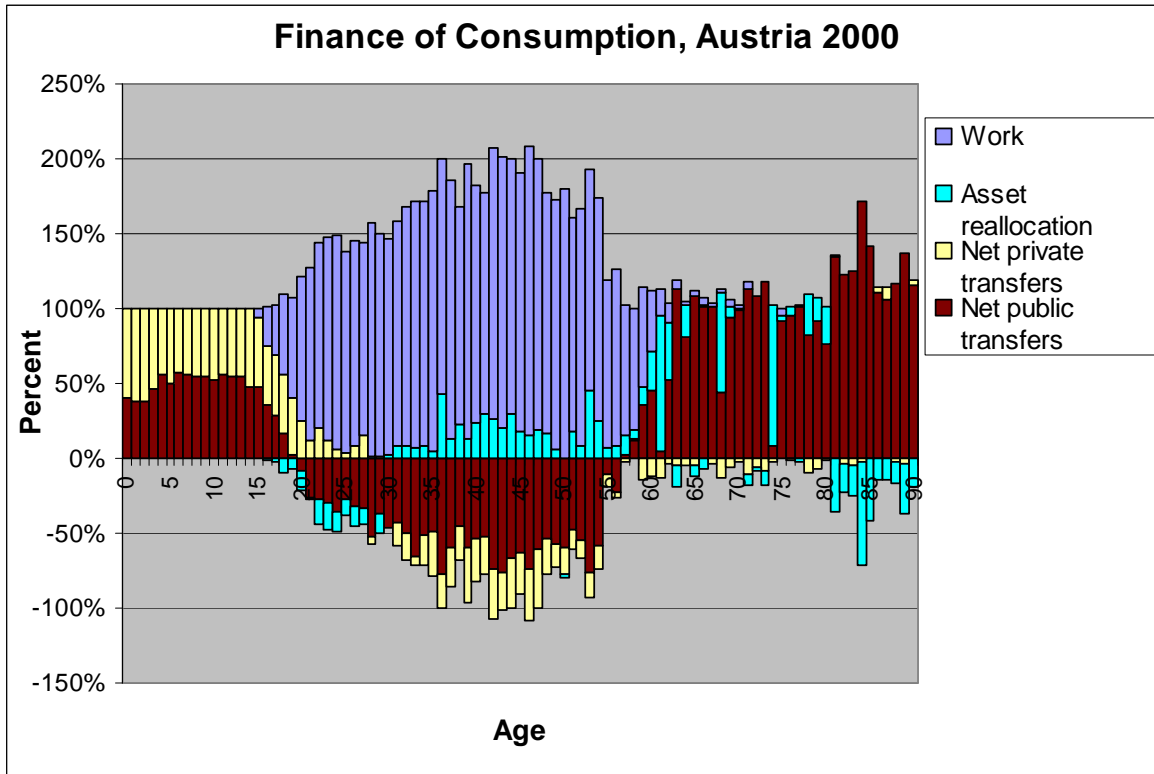
→ Resolved issue of minor miss-matching among intra-household transfers

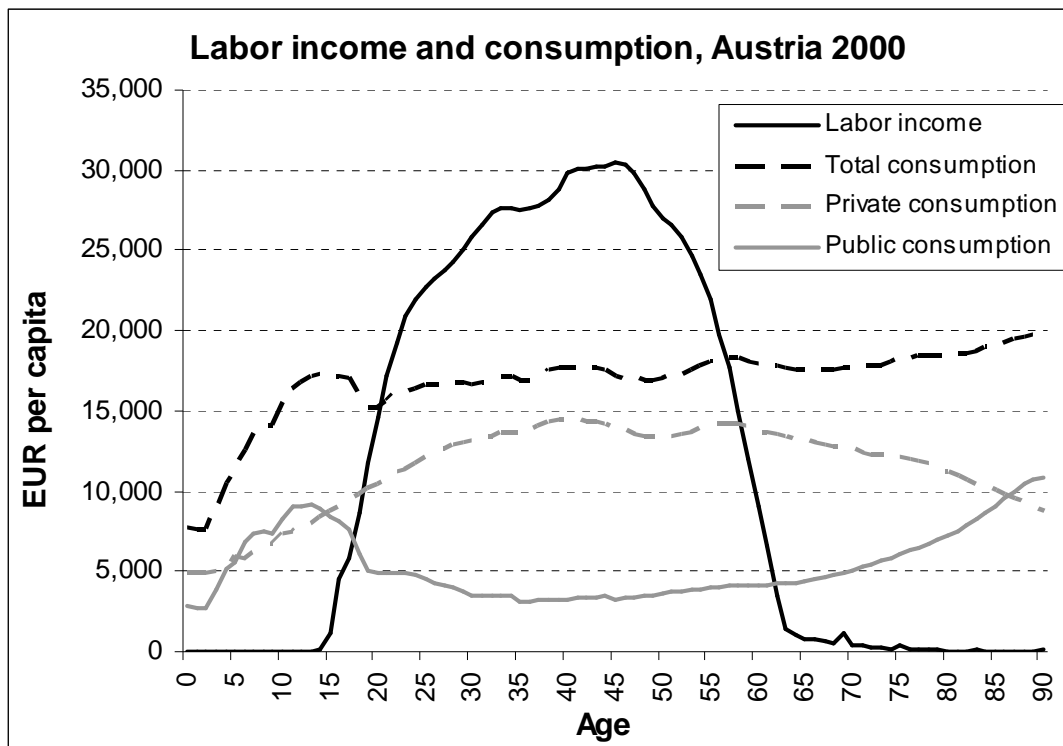
→ Some corrections and fine-tuning the results, like for instance:

→ Main activity: working on asset-based reallocation. However, there are still some issues to resolve and results to be double-checked before presenting them.







Open issues, suggestions and questions

Issue: No data about per capita interest expense. What to use instead?

Question: Automated smoothing procedure (presented by Gretchen, Iván). Consensus to prefer SUPSMU over LOWES?

Suggestion: Big spreadsheet where every country would enter just few words, what is included into each variable (maybe a sheet with links to the methodological descriptions). This would provide:

- Easy checking if the things are done in the right way and

- Warning, which data descriptions are still missing.

Issue: It's quite difficult to follow and find the latest version of the spreadsheets on the NTA webpage.
