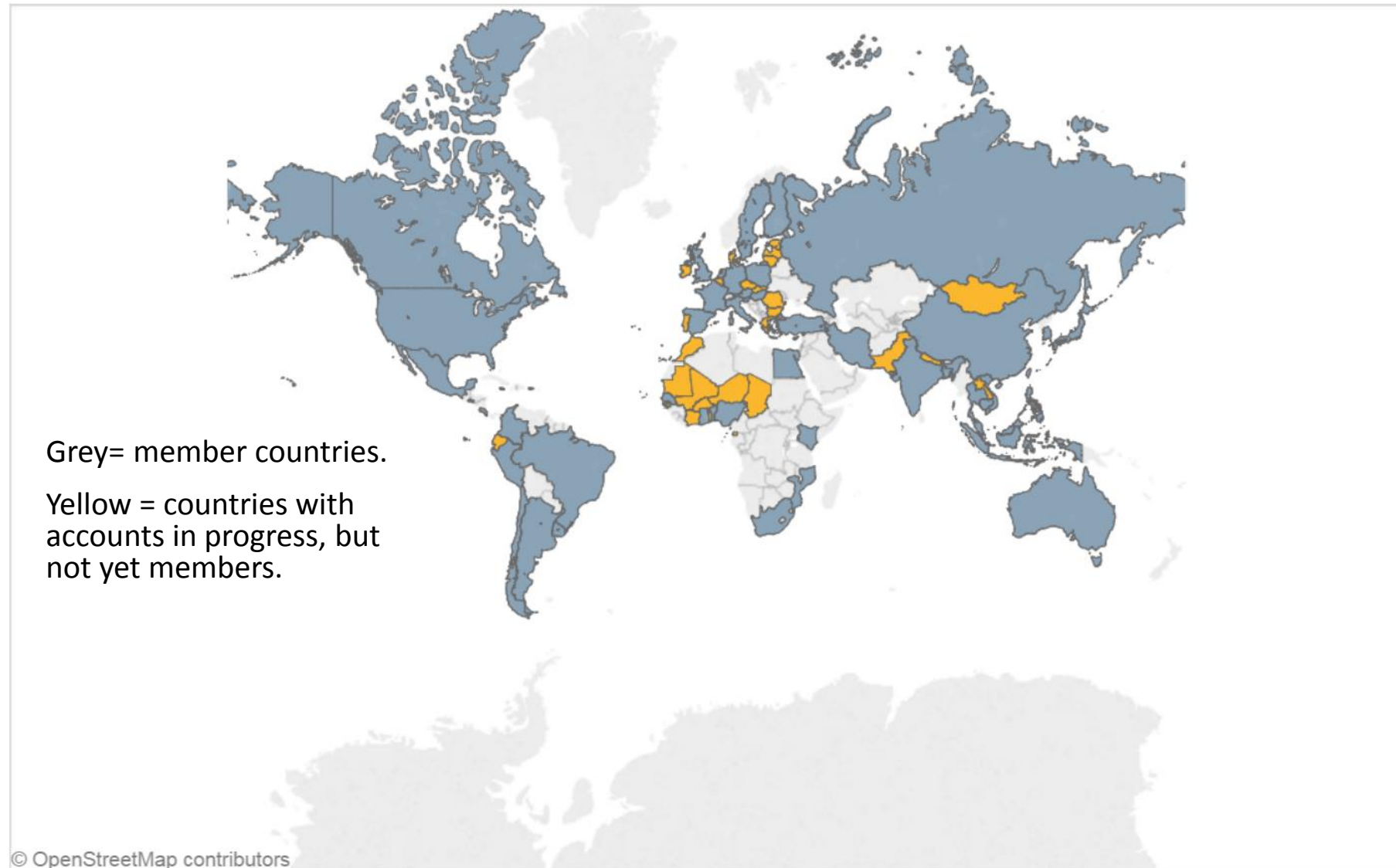

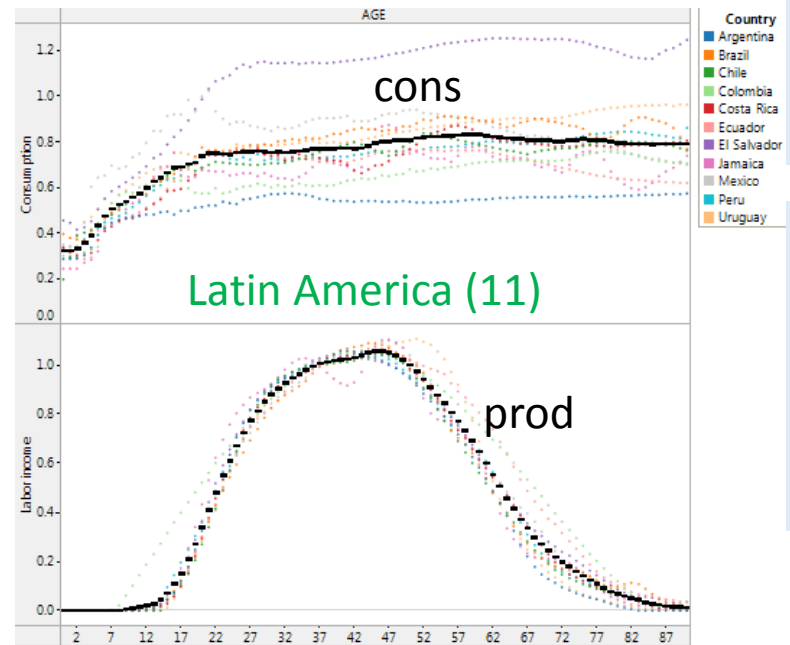
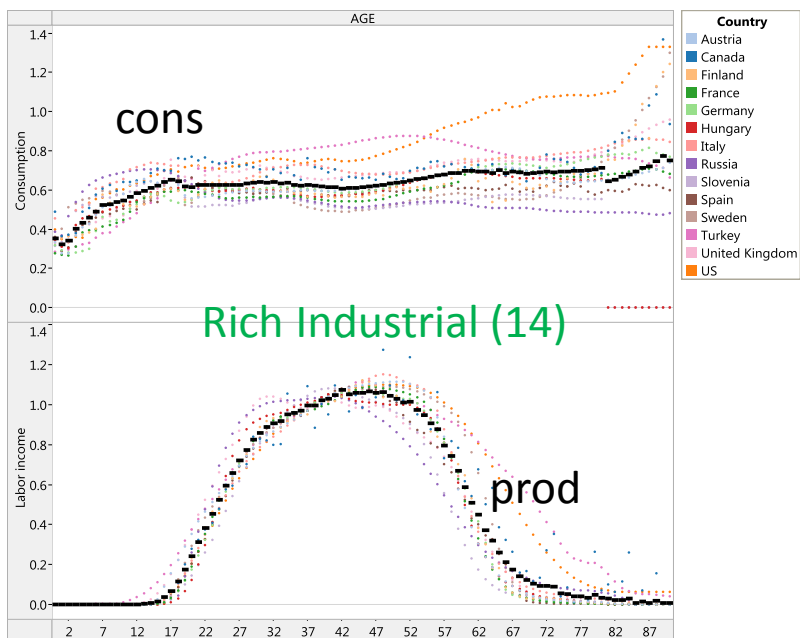
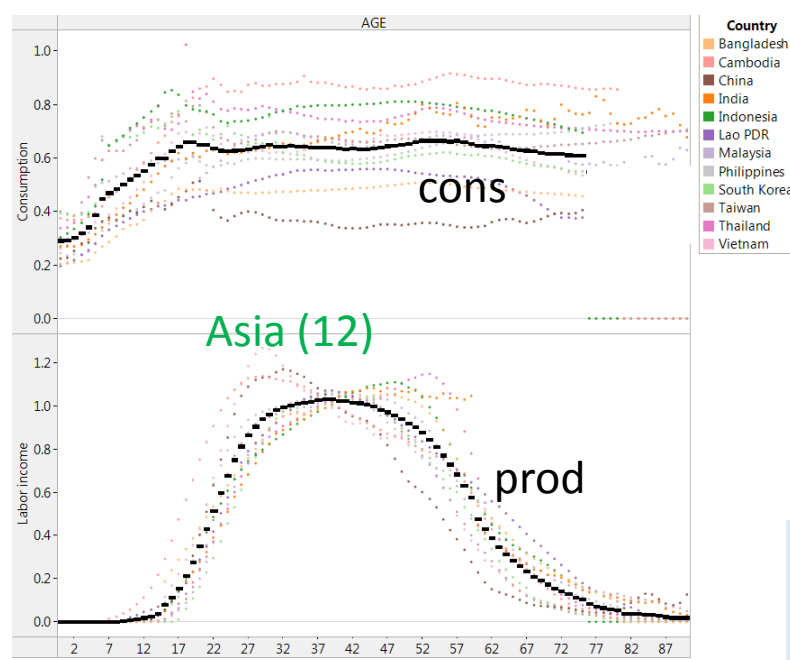
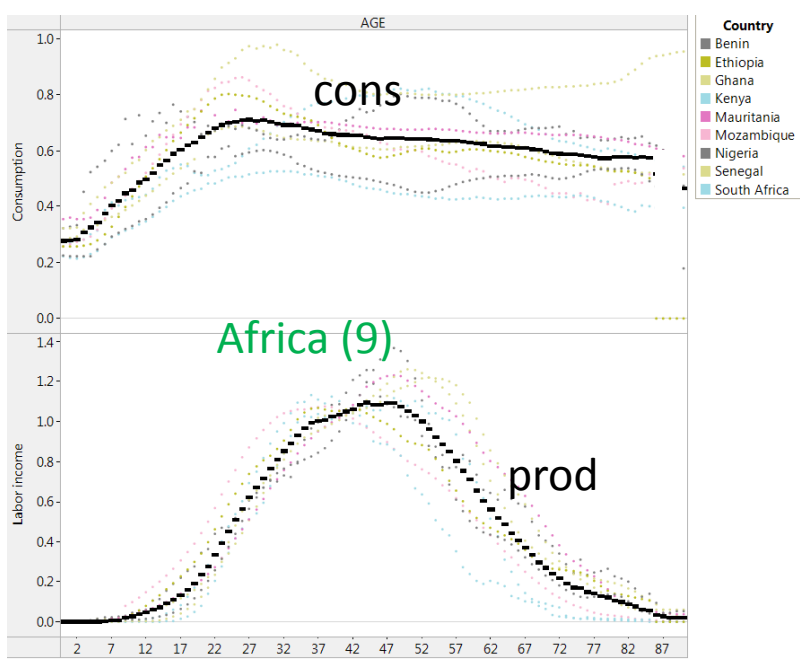

NTA is a global project with member teams in 50 countries (grey) and estimates for another 20 or 30 (yellow).



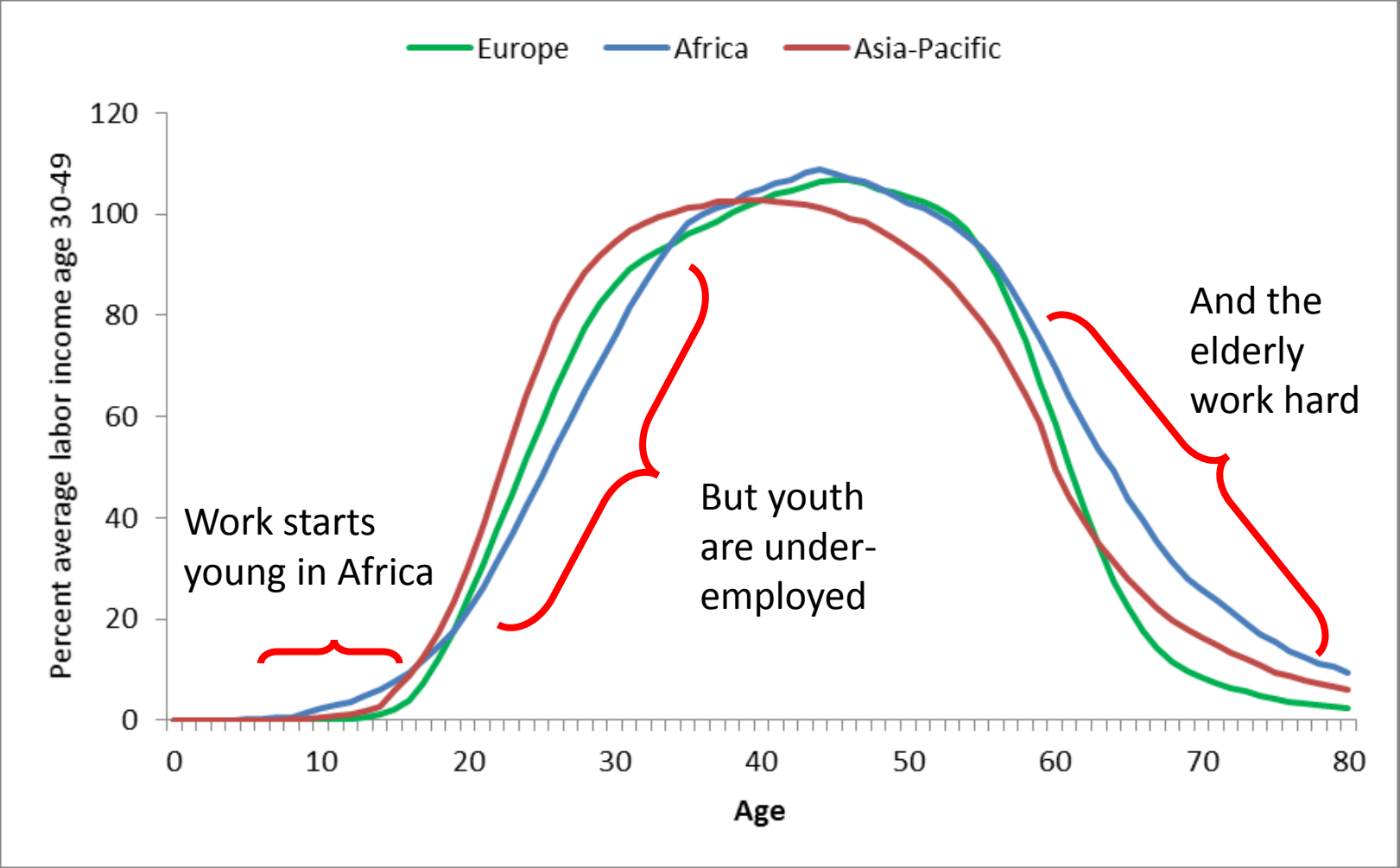


Consumption and Earnings by Age – Regional Averages, relative to earnings at ages 30-49

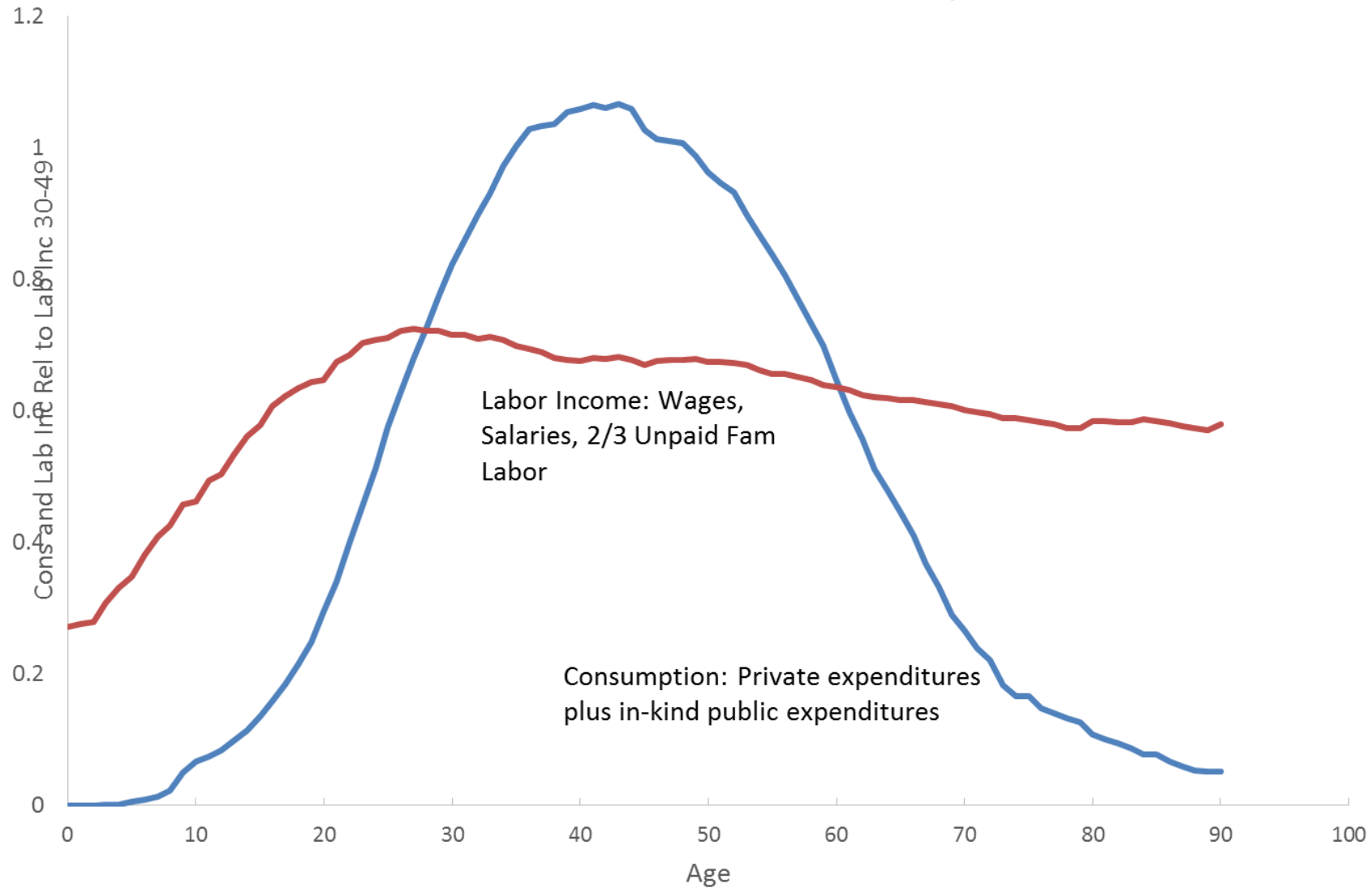
In most countries, the elderly consume like younger adults, on average, or only slightly less.

Can't see it here, but spending on education per child is relatively low in Africa.

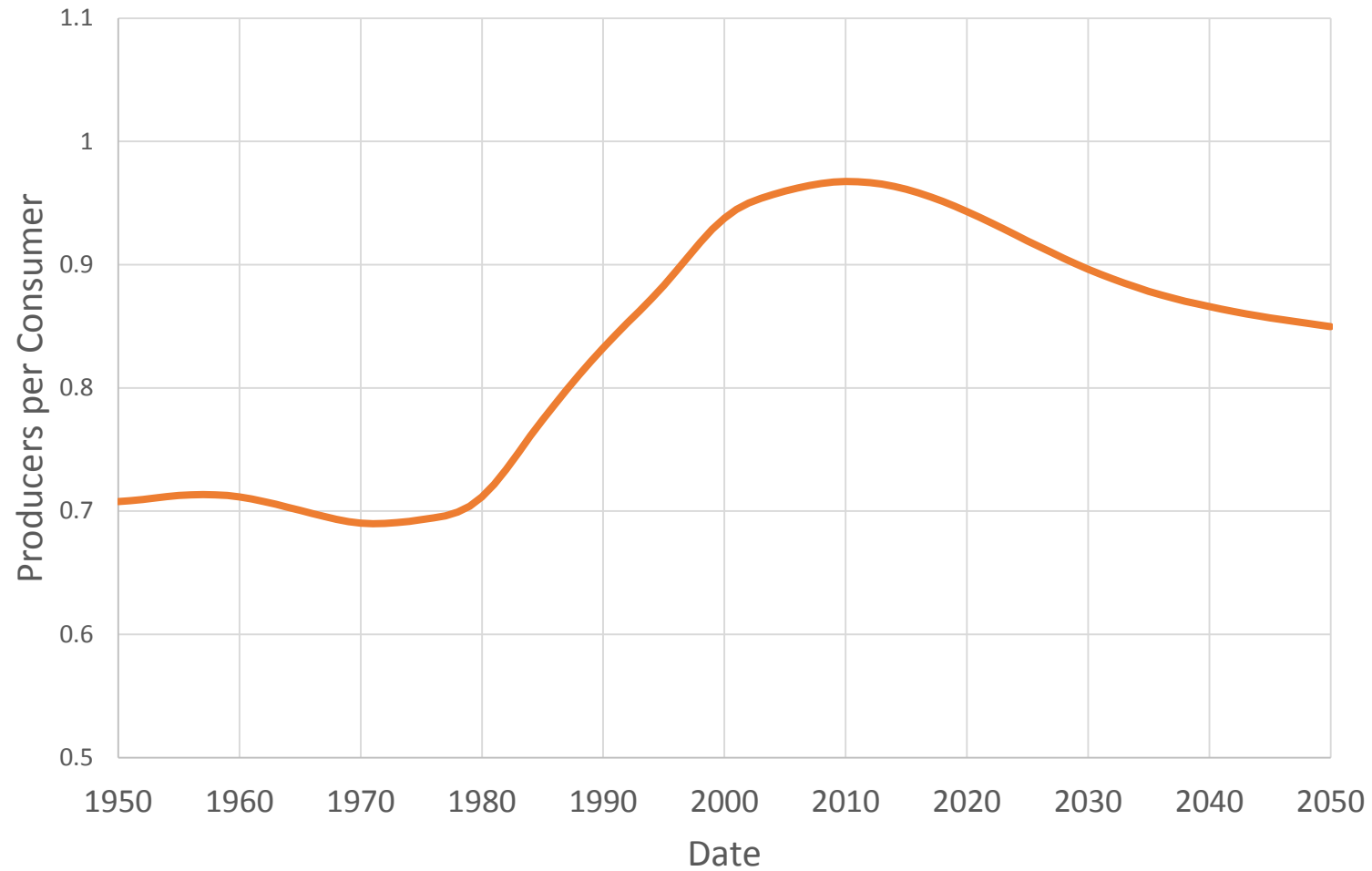
Labor earnings by age, relative to average at ages 30-49



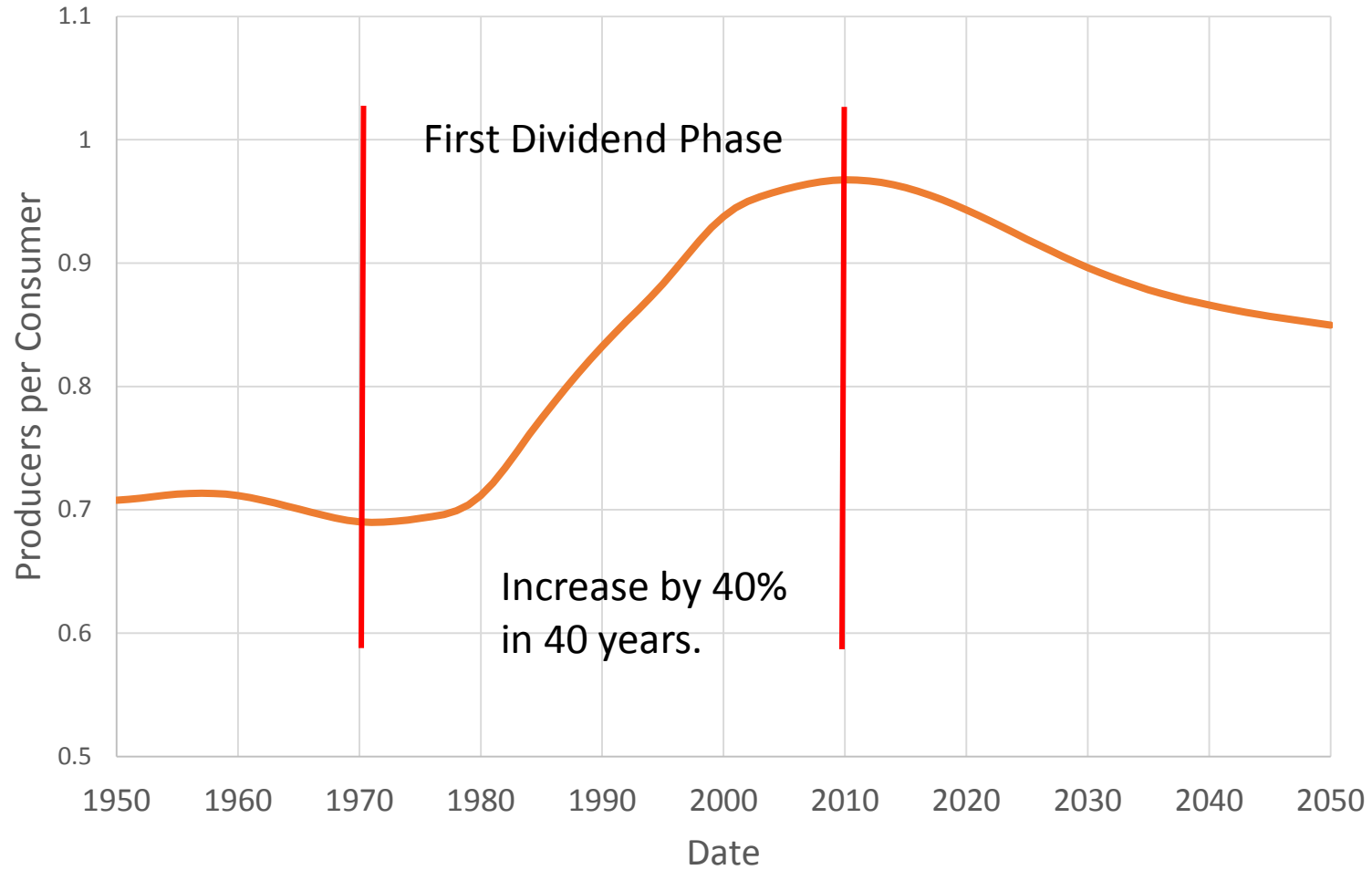
Average Consumption and Labor Income by Age for Seven NTA Countries, Standardized on Labor Inc age 30-49
