Calculating Public Educational Expenditures

- Calculation: (1) Public educational expenditures by level = (a) - (b)
(2) Per capita public expenditures by level = (1) / (c)
(3) Public educational expenditures by age = (2) * (d)
(4) Adjust to match aggregate control values

Notes: Age distribution for 1981-1990 provided with upper interval 80+. It is assumed the age distribution for those aged 80+ in 1981-1990 is the same as that for 1991.
