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

Economic Boom & Government Expansion (Index to 1995)




Methodology: National Transfer Account




$$C(x) - Y^{l}(x) = \tau^{+}(x) - \tau^{-}(x) + Y^{A}(x) - S(x)$$


- Macro data for 2002, 2007, and 2009

- Preliminary results, incomplete estimation





Macro Level Change: Allocations, Transfers, and Savings













Changes in Consumption







Population Aging

- Aging is happening at a fast speed than expected.






When Will the Surplus End?




Sources of Livelihood among Elderly, 2010




Causes of Death, China 1990-2011





Changing Consumption Pattern: Rural 2002/7






Changing Consumption Pattern: Urban 2002/7
